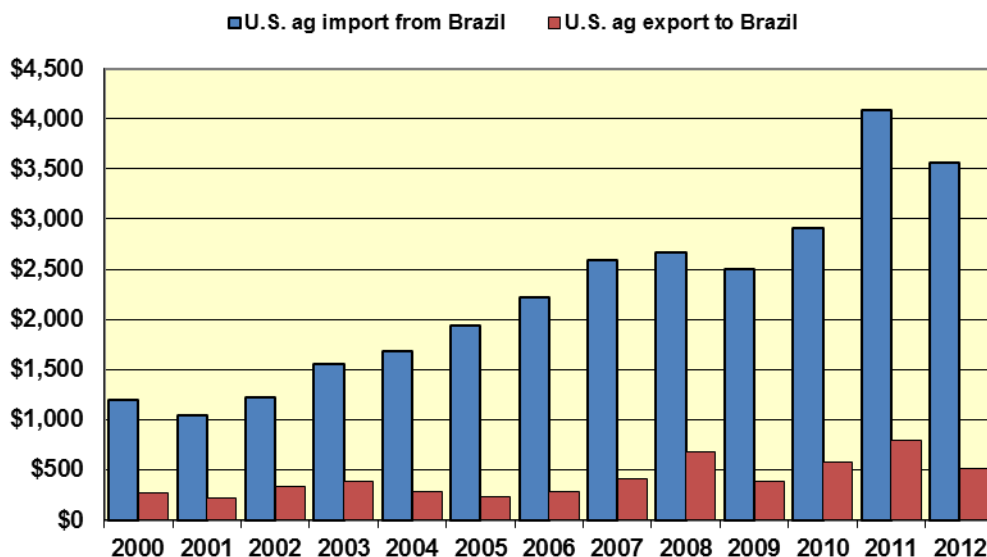


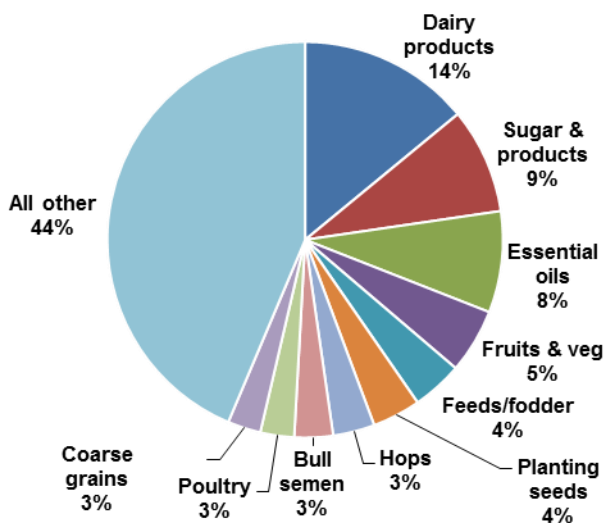
# U.S. AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS TO BRAZIL

- Brazil is the fifth largest country in the world (population and size). It has 201 million people with a land area slightly smaller than the U.S.
- Brazil's GDP ranks No. 10 in the world. It is the largest economy in South America.
- In 2012, U.S. agricultural exports to Brazil totaled **\$515 million**.
- **Ethanol is No. 1** agricultural export from the U.S., with a **47%** market share of the total, followed by dairy and sugar and products.
- Coffee is the largest import commodity from Brazil, followed by tobacco and fruit juices. (U.S. imports do not include sugarcane-based ethanol from Brazil.)

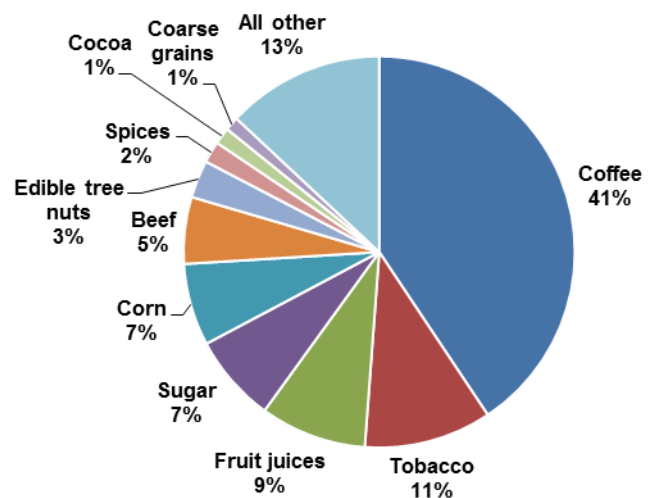
**U.S. Agricultural Exports and Imports: Brazil: 2000-2012 (\$ Million)**
