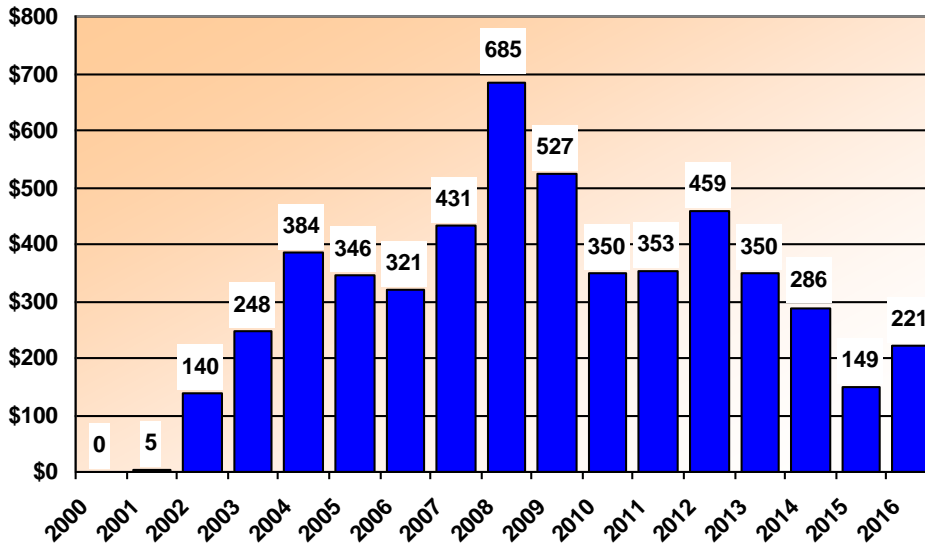


U.S. AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS TO CUBA

- Cuba has a population of 11 million people – about twice of that in Minnesota.
- U.S. agricultural exports to Cuba totaled \$221 million in 2016, up 48% from \$149 million in 2015.
- Cuba ranked No. 54 in country markets for U.S. agricultural exports in 2016, with a 0.16% market-share of the U.S. total ag exports.
- In 2016, poultry meat (broilers and turkey) was the leading U.S. agricultural exports to Cuba – with a market share of 49%, followed by soybeans and products at 30%, and corn at 18%.

U.S. Agricultural Exports to Cuba (2000-2016) – Million \$

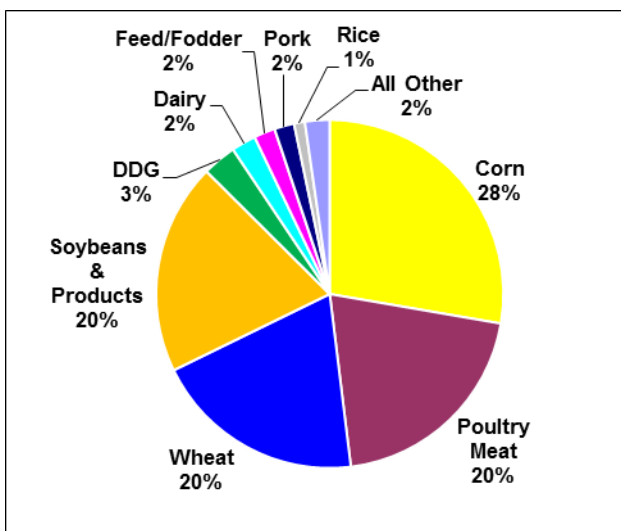

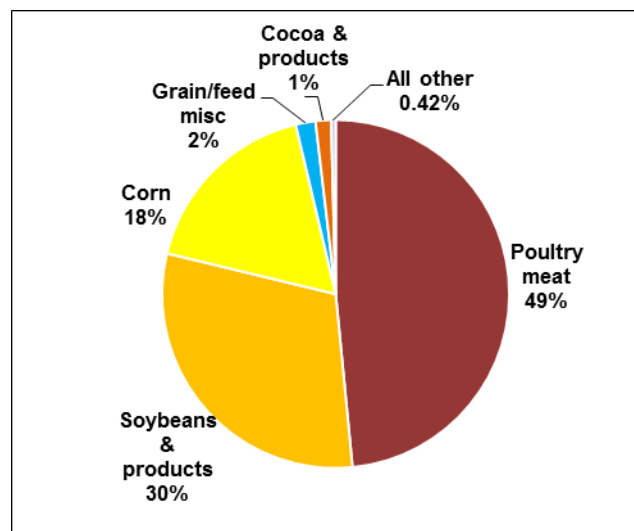
