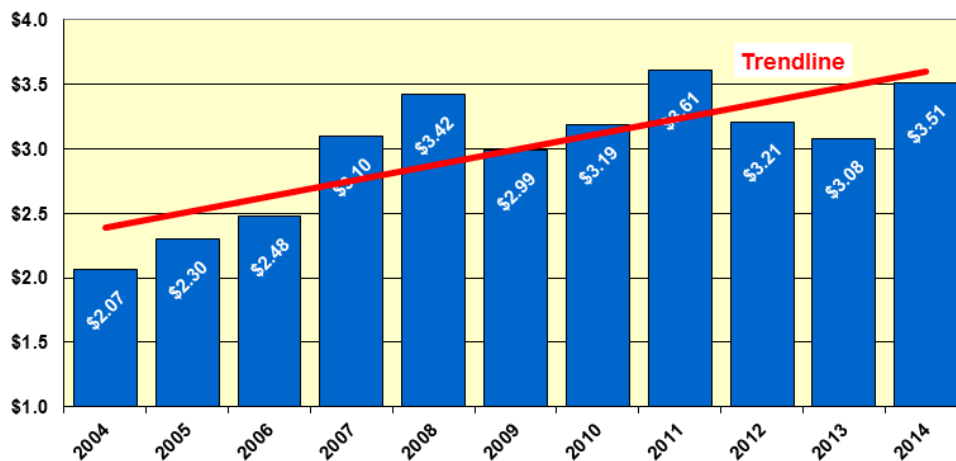


U.S. AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS TO TAIWAN

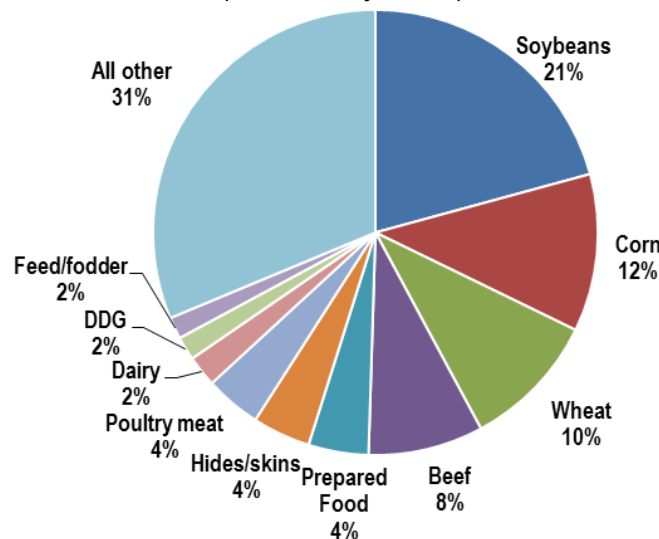
- Taiwan is the sixth largest market for U.S. agricultural exports. On a per-capita basis, it is the largest consumer of U.S. food products.
- Taiwan has a population of 23.1 million. Its GDP production ranks among the top 20 in the world.
- In 2014, U.S. agricultural exports to Taiwan reached **\$3.5 billion**, a second record-high, and a 14% increase from 2013.
- **Soybeans** are Taiwan's **No. 1** agricultural import from the U.S., with an annual trade value of **\$729 million**, followed by **corn** and **wheat**, with annual trade values of **\$400 million** and **\$350 million**, respectively.
- Wheat, beef, processed food, poultry, dairy, and DDG (distiller's dried grains from corn processing) are among the fastest growing U.S. ag exports to Taiwan.
