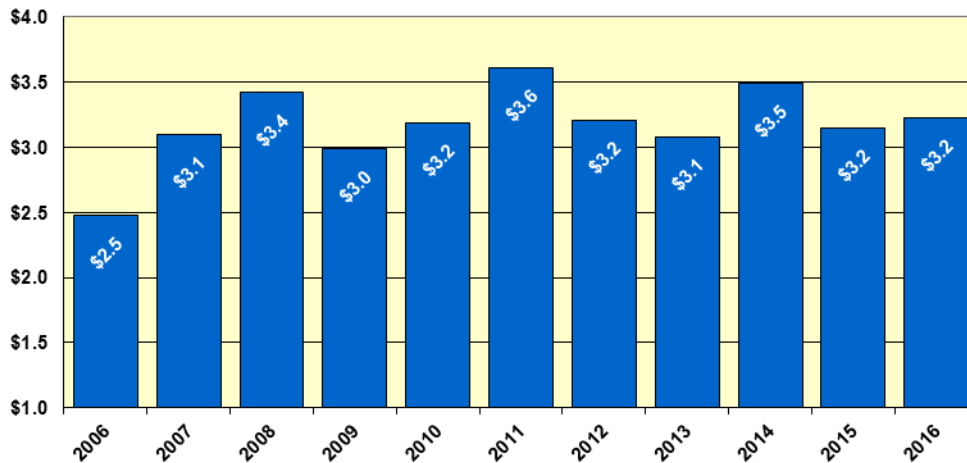


U.S. Agricultural Exports to Taiwan

- Taiwan is the sixth largest market for U.S. agricultural exports. On a per-capita basis, it is the largest consumer of U.S. food products.
- Taiwan has a population of 23.1 million. Its GDP ranks among the top 20 in the world.
- In 2016, U.S. agricultural exports to Taiwan totaled **\$3.2 billion**.
- **Soybeans** are Taiwan's **No. 1** agricultural import from the U.S., with an annual trade value of **\$581 million**, followed by **corn** and **beef**, with annual trade values of **\$459 million** and **\$363 million**, respectively.
- Beef, processed food, poultry/eggs, and dairy are among the fastest growing U.S. agricultural exports to Taiwan.

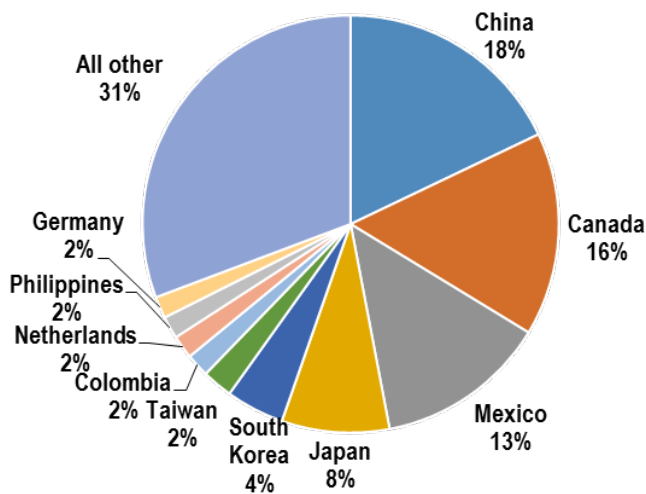
U.S. Agricultural Exports to Taiwan: 2006-2016

(Billion \$)



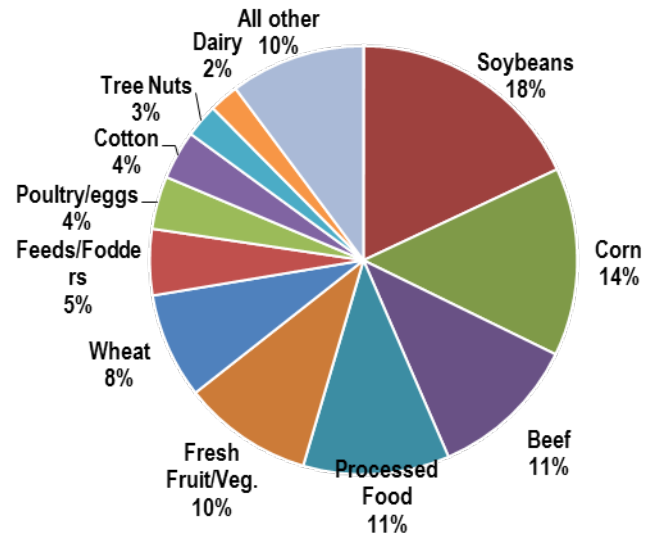
U.S. Ag Exports: Top Markets
