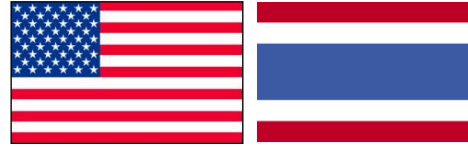
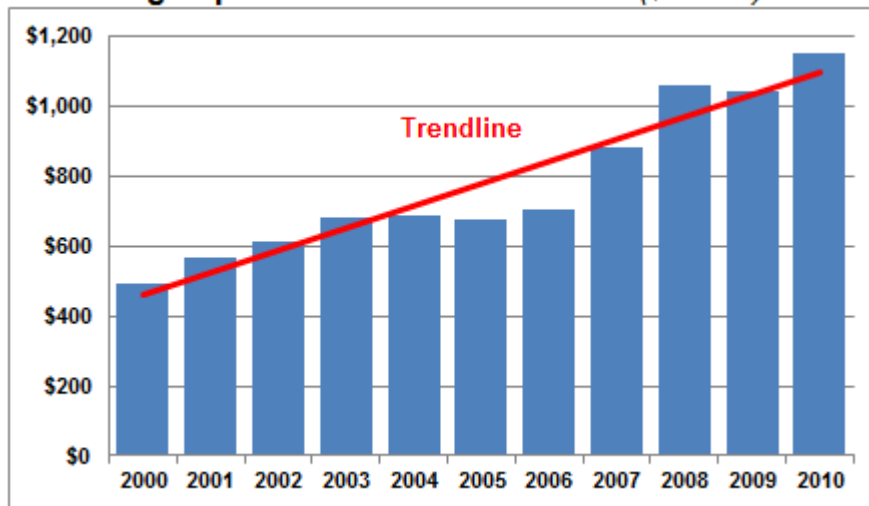


U.S. AGRICULTURAL EXPORTS TO THAILAND

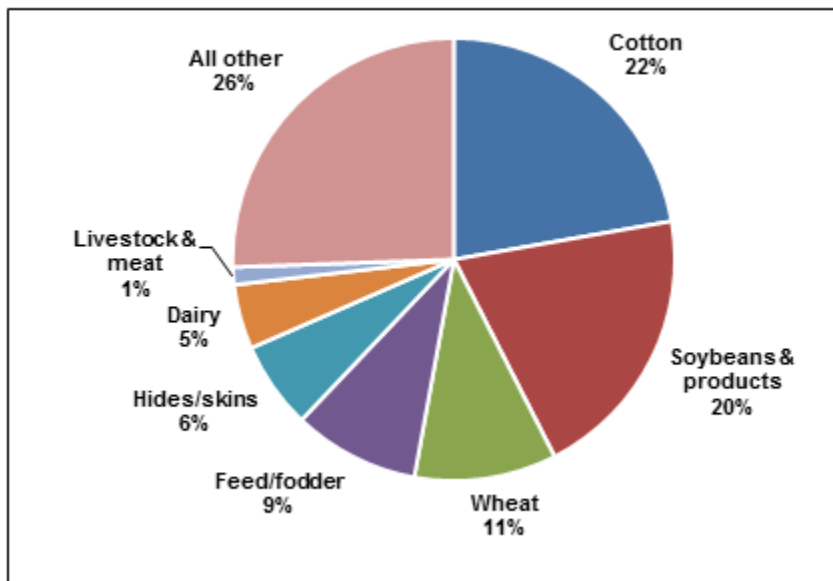
- Thailand is the 16th largest export market for U.S. agricultural products.
- In 2010, U.S. agricultural exports to Thailand reached a record-high of \$1.15 billion, up from \$1.05 billion in 2009, a 10-percent decrease.
- Soybeans, wheat, feed/fodder, hides/skins, dairy, livestock and meat are among the top export commodities from the U.S. to Thailand, and account for 52% of the total.



U.S. Ag Export to Thailand: 2000-2010 (\$ Million)



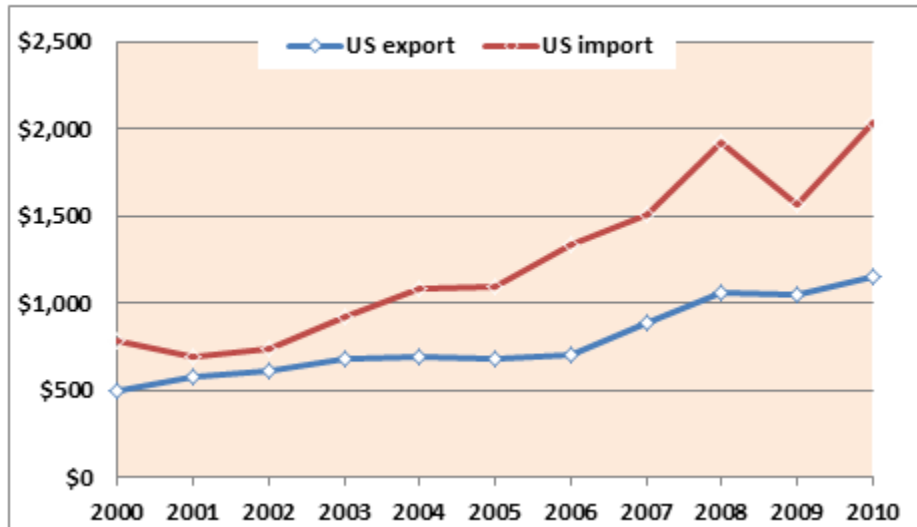
U.S. Ag Export to Thailand by Thailand (2010)



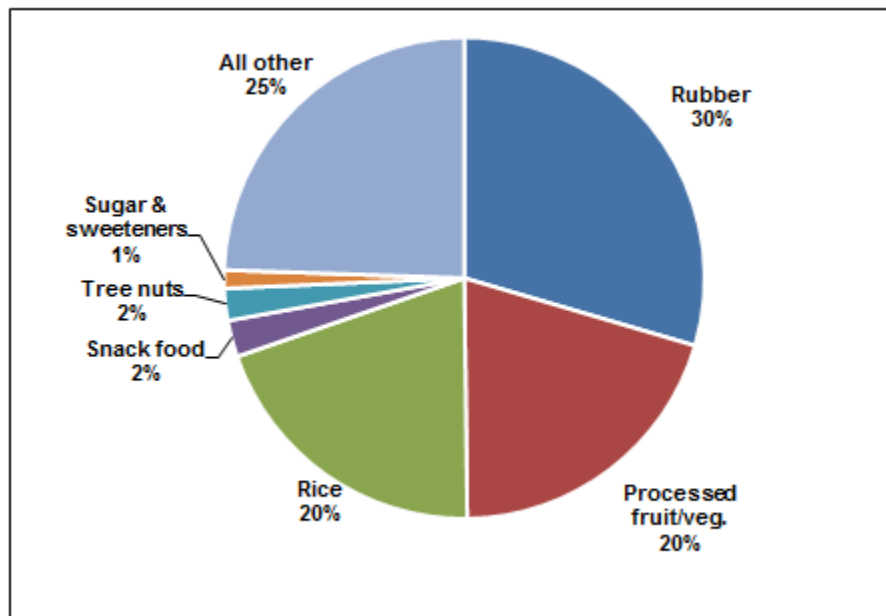
U.S. AGRICULTURAL IMPORTS FROM THAILAND

- The U.S. imported \$2 billion in agricultural products from Thailand in 2010, a 30% increase from 2009.
- The top U.S. import commodities from Thailand are rubber, rice, processed fruit and vegetables, and snack food, accounting for 72% of the total U.S. ag imports from Thailand.
