## How do I exercise trade secret protection?

- A) Clearly mark "Not Public" or "Confidential" on any material or portion thereof that in your opinion would, if made public, compromise trade secrets.
- B) Submit a written letter that justifies trade secret protection. In your letter you must:
  - 1) Demonstrate that you or your organization supplied the marked data;
  - 2) Describe how the marked data is the subject of efforts by you or your organization that are reasonable under the circumstances to maintain its secrecy; and
  - 3) Describe how the marked data derives independent economic value, actual or potential, from not being generally known to, and not being readily ascertainable by proper means by other persons who can obtain economic value from its disclosure or use.

The letter should be provided at the time the data is supplied in order to exercise these rights immediately. You may attach the letter to your application. If you submit the letter after already submitting your application, address the letter to Data Practices Coordinator, Plant Protection Division, Minnesota Department of Agriculture, 625 Robert Street North, St. Paul, MN 55155-2538. If you have already submitted such a letter regarding this data, you do not need to submit another unless you are asking for protection of additional data.
