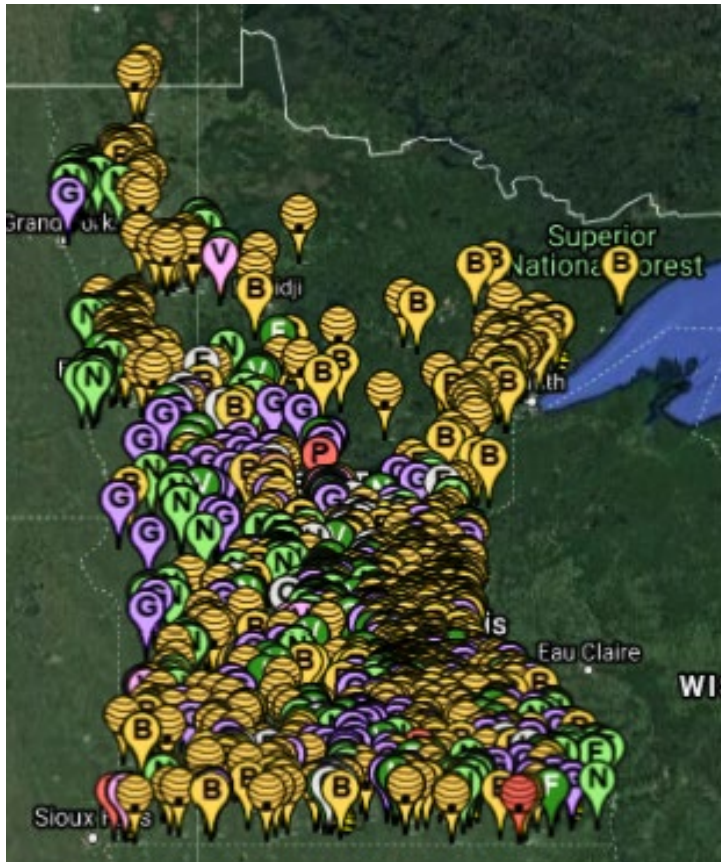


## DriftWatch for Hemp Growers

February 2021

DriftWatch is a program that allows growers of specialty crop, such as industrial hemp, to mark the locations of their fields on a map. This provides pesticide applicators with a simple way to locate pesticide sensitive crops and beehives so precautions can be taken when spraying in these areas. The program is operated by FieldWatch, a nonprofit company, and is free for specialty crop producers and beekeepers.

Each pin on the map is a registered site. The abbreviation in the pin indicates the crop at that location. By zooming in closer, the field borders become visible. Select a pin to obtain contact information for that producer.
