  - Assessments in progress to continue in 2025
    - Winged burning bush variety 'Fireball Seedless'
    - Yellow archangel
    - Hardy kiwi
    - 'Freedom' honeysuckle seed germination test to inform about invasive potential. 'Freedom' is a Tatarian honeysuckle hybrid that is regulated.
